

MEASURES TO ADAPT YOUR GROUP COACH TRIP

Since the world is experiencing an unprecedented health crisis, exceptional measures have been implemented to ensure your safety throughout your trip. Your comfort, happiness, and well-being are a priority for us.

BEFORE YOUR COACH TRIP

- Make sure that your health status allows you to travel. Monitor yourself for the common symptoms of COVID-19 and take your temperature.
- Stay informed. Much like the measures, the situation evolves rapidly. Check the websites of your destination to know whether you need to take additional health measures.
- Wearing a mask or face covering is mandatory on board the coach. We recommend bringing several for your comfort, depending on the duration of your trip.



BOARDING

Baggage placement

- Place your baggage in the appropriate location designated by the driver.

Boarding

- Maintain the required physical distancing with other passengers unless you are from the same household.
- The guide will conduct the head count of the passengers in order of entry from back to front.



- You must remain in the same seats throughout the trip. Seat changes will be possible following the daily cleaning of the vehicle.



- To help maintain the required physical distancing on board the coach, the blocking of adjacent seats or the installation of physical barriers in the coach will be implemented.



- Wash your hands before each embarkation point.

ON BOARD THE COACH

Each day, a deep cleaning will be done for the entire vehicle, including seats, belt buckles, lighting and ventilation controls, shelves, and baggage compartments. In addition, the common surfaces touched by passengers will be disinfected using a hydroalcoholic solution twice per day.

The coaches are equipped with efficient filters that help clean the air on board the vehicles as well as constant ventilation that allows the passengers to have fresh air refreshed several times per hour.



- You must wear a mask or face covering at all times.

- It is prohibited to get up during the trip.

- The coach washroom cannot be used. Frequent stops will be scheduled along the route as an alternative measure.



- The consumption of food is prohibited in the coaches, except for water bottles.



DISEMBARKING OF PASSENGERS



- Passengers disembark from front to back.
- Maintain the required physical distancing with other passengers unless you are from the same household.
- At the end of the day, passengers must leave the vehicle with all their effects to allow for the complete cleaning of the coach.



BAGGAGE COLLECTION

- Baggage is placed in a location designated by the driver.
- Passengers collect their baggage while respecting physical distancing.
